- exploring the rationale and thinking underlying various research designs;
- evaluating the strengths and weaknesses of various data collection tools;
- reflecting on practical and theoretical issues involved in conducting empirical research including ethical concerns;
- supporting participants in developing their own research projects by applying ideas to practical examples.
- identifying research issues in applied linguistics;
- drafting and piloting research questions;
- using mixed methods in applied linguistics research;
- innovative methodologies in applied linguistics research;
- writing and publishing applied linguistics research;
- presenting and networking at applied linguistics conferences;
- building an academic profile as an applied linguistics researcher;
- bridging research and practice in the applied linguistics context;
- leveraging the impact of applied linguistics research.
